Day 1. Fri 14 February 2020 D **MACKAY - BRISBANE - AUCKLAND -** **BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA**

Meet at Mackay Airport and begin our journey to Buenos Aires, Argentina via Brisbane and Auckland. We cross the international date line and upon arrival, we are transferred to our hotel. This evening is at leisure with dinner included at the hotel to get to know your fellow travellers.

Discover this unique city with its mix of colonial architecture and European influences. Visit the Plaza de Mayo, Recoleta Cemetery and the colourful quarter of La Boca. The remainder of the day and evening is at leisure.

Day 3. Sun 16 February 2020 B D **BUENOS AIRES**

Day 4. Mon 17 February 2020 B D **BUENOS AIRES**

The tour will provide you with the opportunity to discover the local flora and Sub-Antarctic landscapes. You may be lucky to encounter beavers, birds, wild orchids etc. This is a true paradise for Nature lovers.

Port Lockroy

During your cruise, your ship will call at Port Lockroy, a surprising natural harbour sitting in the heart of the Antarctic Peninsula. Discovered by the explorer Jean-Baptiste Charcot, over the years it has served as a relief and repair base for whalers and a British military base in turn, and it is now a scientific research station. Today, it is considered to be the most visited site in the Antarctic, thanks to its small museum that retraces the life of the station from the 1950s onward, and its souvenir shop. Do not miss your chance to stop by the world's Southernmost post office, to write to your loved ones and share this special moment with them.

Weddell Sea

A lengthy sail in the Weddell Sea, a labyrinth in which majestic tabletop icebergs abound, will allow you to experience an extraordinary and enchanting atmosphere enhanced by true silence. Here, the gigantic platforms of ice and the ice caps sculpt a landscape like no other, home to fur seals, penguin colonies, wandering albatrosses and giant petrels. The lords of this realm, the Weddell seals, will welcome you to their lands as the roar of their cries occasionally disturbs the tranquillity of the place.

Deception Island

Nestling in the north of the Antarctic Peninsula, Deception Island rewards the traveller's gaze with volcanic beaches and the vestiges of its abandoned huts. This was an important whaling port for a long time and in the early 19th century it became a refuge where sailors could wait for storms or icebergs to pass. The island's greatest asset is its exceptional wildlife. Today Deception Island is home to one of the largest colonies of chinstrap penguins in the Antarctic Peninsula, as well as elephant seals and fur seals.

Drake Passage

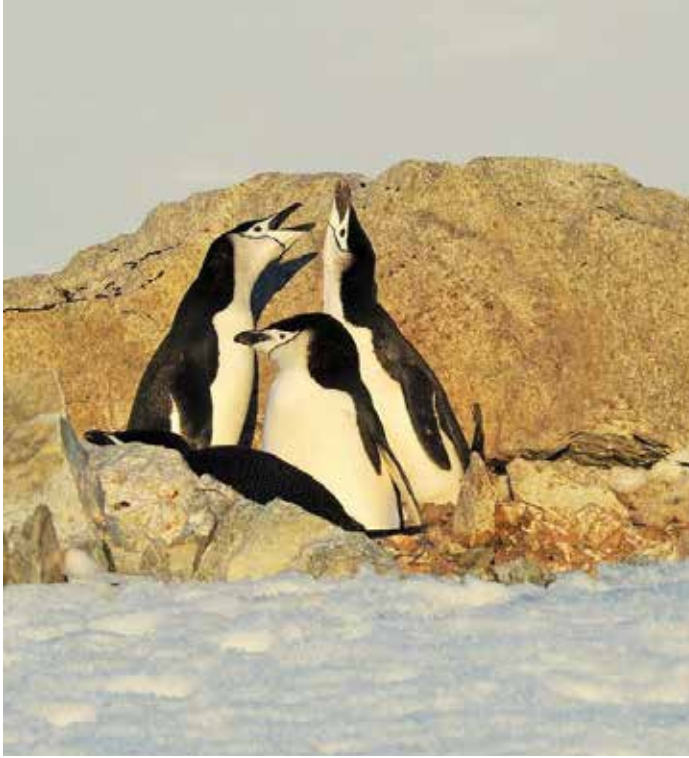
If there is one place, one sea, one passage that visitors, scientists and other sailors fear in the Antarctic, it is Drake Passage. Lying at the latitude where the famous Furious Fifties are prevalent, between Cape Horn and the South Shetland Islands, it is the shortest way to reach the Antarctic. Seasoned travellers will tell you that you have to earn the right to see the White Continent... The "Antarctic Convergence" zone, where the northward-flowing Antarctic waters meet the warmer equatorial waters, is home to a rich variety of marine wildlife. But don't forget to look up in order to spot elegant albatrosses and Cape petrels as they play on the wind around your ship.

Ushuaia

Each of your cruises offers you the opportunity to discover the world's southernmost city: Ushuaia. The Argentina capital of Tierra del Fuego is considered the gateway to the "Great White" and the South Pole. Nicknamed "El fin del mundo" by the Argentinian people, this city at the end of the world nestles in the shelter of mountains surrounded by fertile plains that the wildlife seem to have chosen as the ultimate sanctuary. With its exceptional site, where the Andes plunge straight into the sea, Ushuaia is one of the most fascinating places on earth, its very name evocative of journeys to the unlikely and the inaccessible...

Exceptional wildlife

Visiting Antarctica is a chance to explore the most extreme of all continents and discover a mysterious and unspoiled land far from the frenzy of the most popular tourist sites. Numerous species have taken up residence at the heart of this icy realm, and at the different ports of call you will be able to get closer to penguins, which are symbolic of this region and live in vast colonies. Gentoo, Adélie and Chinstrap penguins are placid animals and are sure to win your heart as they waddle back and forth from the sea to the beach to feed their young. At sea, you may be lucky enough to see elegant humpback whales greet you with their melodious song and surprising acrobatics, while off in the distance imposing seals bask in the sunshine. If you look up, you will be able to observe the many albatrosses and snow petrels playing on the wind behind your ship.

The icebergs

During your cruise, you will sail amid icy giants standing in vertical lines like white ships draped in fog. Calved by the ice caps and composed only of fresh water, these crystal cathedrals are a hallmark of polar landscapes and they carry not only the history of the ice cap and glacier they come from, but also the marks of the waves that sculpt their silhouette. Get close to these natural works of art aboard our Zodiac inflatables. Sometimes you will see them toppling or crashing into one another and you will understand the complex nature of this powerful yet fragile environment.

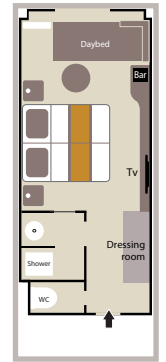

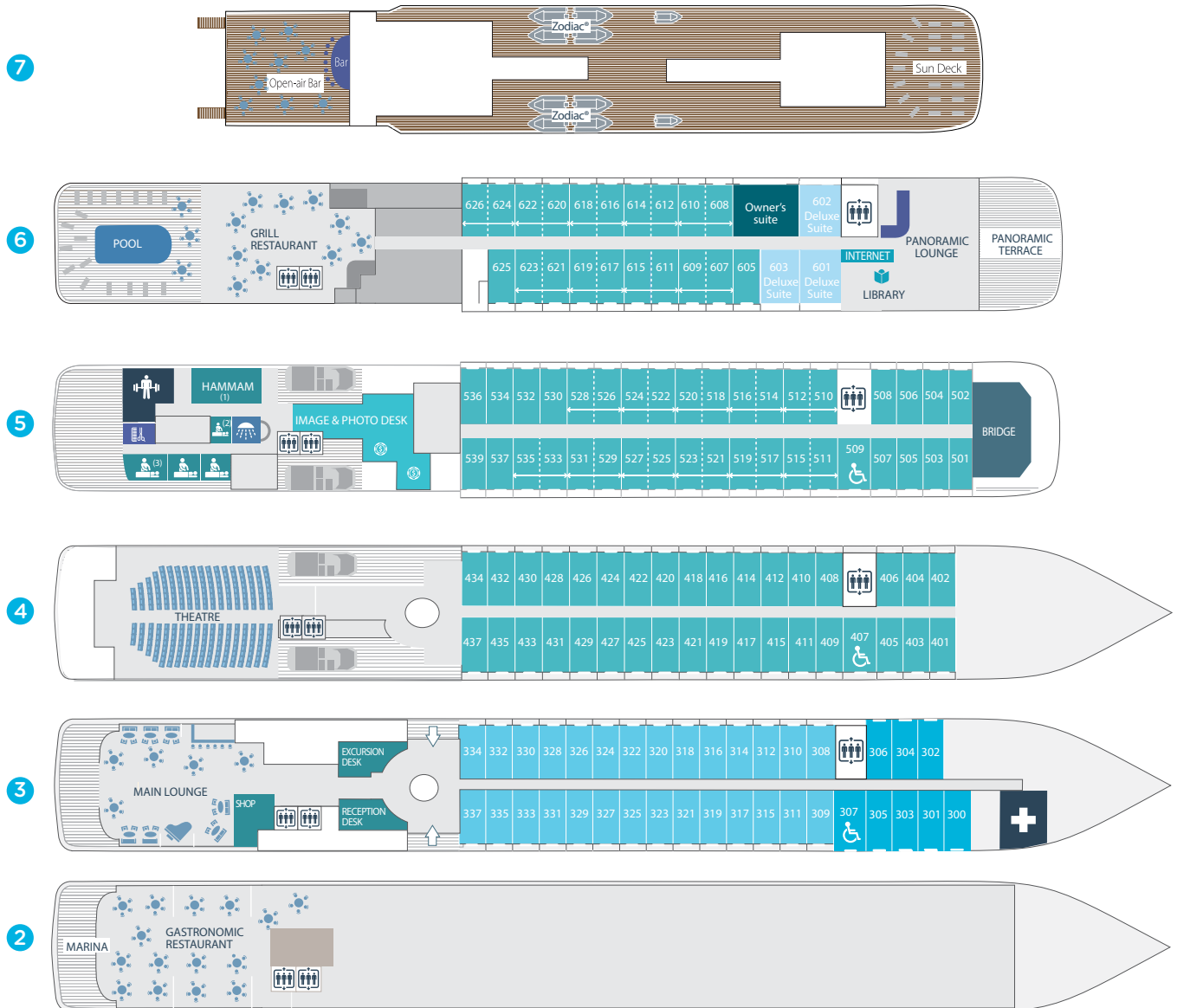

Fiesta Gauchi Tour **\$285pp**

This excursion takes you to the Argentine countryside where you can enjoy a day on a ranch 'estancia' and discover its traditional dance and music, joining a true 'Festival Gaucho'. Typical empanadas and Argentine wine will be served at the welcoming party. Later, you will enjoy a delicious Argentine-style barbecue and a folkloric show with music and dance will take place. Typical gauchos will show their horse-riding skills. A horse exhibition and the 'sortija' will also be part of the show. Ride a horse or on a typical 'sulki' to get a feel for the way of life of the gaucho.



Tigre Delta Tour + lunch **\$255pp**

Travel from Buenos Aires through the northern neighbourhoods of Olivos, Martinez, La Lucila, Acassusso and San Isidro.
