This photographic journey captures the natural wonders of Tasmania's rugged mountains, spectacular coastlines and ancient rain forests making it one of Australia's last true wilderness frontiers. With sweeping bays, picturesque beaches and sparkling lakes, you will be amazed and inspired with endless photography opportunities.

DAY 1. Fri 6 November 2020 [MACKAY - HOBART

Let's meet at the Mackay Airport and begin our journey to Hobart, Tasmania.

We will be met at the airport by our guest Photographer Guide, Cameron Blake, and transfer to our hotel.

After checking in, we experience our first photography location, Mt Wellington Summit. At 1,270 metres, Mt. Wellington provides absolutely stunning views of Hobart and the surrounding area; the Derwent Estuary, Storm Bay and beyond. This National Park Reserve connects the city to the bush, and the mountains to the waterways. Be prepared to sit atop Tasmania as we take in the 360 degree views of this magnificent region.

Tonight we enjoy a welcome dinner at our hotel.

DAY 2. Sat 7 November 2020 B D ST HELENS

This morning we travel up the spectacular east coast of Tasmania along the Great Eastern Drive which extends between Orford and St Helens.

We stop to explore the township of Orford that offers riverside and bayside beauty. We continue onto Swansea, a pretty seaside village that looks out over Great Oyster Bay to the spectacular granite peaks of Freycinet National Park.

This afternoon, we continue to the Freycinet Peninsula, one of best known and loved destinations on Tasmania's east coast, Wineglass Bay and

surrounds. Stunning views await us after a leisurely walk up the Hazards Lookout track.

Tonight dinner is at our hotel.

DAY 3. Sun 8 November 2020 B D BAY OF FIRES

This morning after breakfast, we head north, further up the east coast to visit the incredibly beautiful conservation reserve, Bay of Fires. This slice of coastal heaven has been named by Lonely Planet as the hottest travel destination in the world, and is widely regarded as one of the most beautiful places in Australia. It is famous for its crystal-clear waters, white sandy beaches and orange lichen-covered granite boulders. Lock and load the cameras for a sunrise event like no other as the sun makes it's way over the horizon and lights up the redorange lichen landscape.

We then make our way inland via one of Tasmania's tallest waterfalls, St. Columba Falls, with a drop of over 90 metres. Afterwards, we continue our journey to capture the lush greens and towering old growth rainforests of the Blue Tiers region - an exposed subalpine plateau 600 metres above sea level, with a rich mining history and magnificent natural heritage.

We make our scenic return to our hotel for dinner.

DAY 4. Mon 9 November 2020 LAUNCESTON B D

After breakfast, we travel inland as we leave the crystal blue waters and white sands of the east coast behind us as

we make our way towards Tassie's second biggest city, Launceston.

Along the way we visit the very popular photo spot, Jacobs Ladder, the name of the sharply winding ascent in a steep and narrow zig-zag road in Ben Lomond Range. Ben Lomond National Park is dominated by an alpine plateau over 1500 metres high and surrounded by precipitous escarpments.

We also visit the Cataract Gorge Reserve on the South Esk River, a unique natural formation just minutes from central Launceston. The Gorge has walking tracks, a swimming pool, the world's longest single span chairlift, a restaurant, cafe, a suspension bridge and panoramic lookouts with spectacular views. Peacocks and native wildlife add to the experience.

We retire to our hotel and have dinner.

DAY 5. Tue 10 November 2020 CRADLE MOUNTAIN B

This morning as we make our way from Launceston, we visit one of the state's prettiest falls, Liffey Falls, nestled in the cool temperate rainforest of the Great Western Tiers mountain range. Liffey Falls State Reserve is part of the Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area. The Liffey River rises and plunges through dense rainforest of myrtle, sassafras and leatherwood, running over several magnificent waterfalls before reaching rich farmlands and joining the South Esk River.

We will then continue our journey through the beautiful township of Sheffield, the town of murals.

Once a centre for industry, the town has reinvented itself as an arts community. Featuring more than 140 murals, Sheffield is Tasmania's own outdoor art gallery. The murals portray the history of the area and feature Cradle Mountain pioneer Gustav Weindorfer, Tasmanian Tigers, and pictorial representations of characters and stories of the past.

We then continue on to capture the views of Mt Roland, standing at 1233 metres above sea level and provides a stunning backdrop to the Kentish Municipality. The walk takes in the plains and plateau leading to the summit of the peak.

Then, as excitement builds, we make our way to Cradle Mountain National Park for what are considered some of the best views in Australia. We will experience and capture views of sunset over Dove Lake and Cradle Mountain.

Dinner this evening, is at a local restaurant.

DAY 6. Wed 11 November 2020 CRADLE MOUNTAIN B

We rise early to experience a spectacular Cradle Mountain sunrise. This is one of the most exhilarating experiences one can have with a camera in hand. If conditions are favourable, we will capture one of the world's most incredible landscapes.

We return to our hotel to enjoy the delights of our hearty breakfast hamper before spending the remainder of the morning exploring Cradle Mountain and Dove Lake circuit. Tasmania's famous Cradle Mountain towers over glacial

lakes creating a breathtaking scene. The Dove Lake circuit is known to be one of Tasmania's premier nature walks. The trail circles Dove Lake, a glacially carved lake, while taking you beneath the craggy spires of the indomitable Cradle Mountain. This two-hour circuit is boardwalk for much of the way and is suitable for most.

Take in the scenic views as we return to our hotel via three beautiful waterfalls, Pencil Pine Cascades, Pencil Pine Falls and Kynvet Falls, right on the doorstep of the National Park.

We dine locally for dinner tonight.

DAY 7. Thu 12 November 2020 STRAHAN B D

In the morning after devouring our delicious breakfast hamper, we journey down the wild west coast of Tasmania as we head to our next destination Strahan. Watch as the scenery changes around every corner, with views an landscapes that will astonish us.

Enroute, we visit the historic townships of Waratah, Zeehan and Rosebery. Waratah is a small, scenic town on the edge of the Tarkine wilderness with a rich mining past, a magnificent townside waterfall and a unique lakeside setting. Nestled deep within a secret valley, Rosebery is surrounded by a striking landscape of dense forest and the volcanic mountains of the West Coast Range. Hidden in a valley of rugged hills and rainforest, Zeehan is renowned for it's unique geological structures.

As we come into Strahan, we make a

stop at Henty Dunes, a series of giant dunes reaching several kilometres inland and extending 15 kilometres along the coast. Reaching heights of around 30 metres, the Henty Sand Dunes are a desert amid the rainforests of Tasmania's west coast, as well as Ocean Beach Lookout.

This evening, we dine at our hotel.


DAY 8. Fri 13 November 2020 B D TARRALEAH

As we start our journey from the west coast back towards Hobart, we pass through the impressive township of Queenstown. Surrounded by towering mountains, we will notice the lack of vegetation that grows around these hills. Queenstown was one the largest copper mining towns in the world and is now considered one of the most interesting destinations in Tasmania. Grand old buildings, classic old locomotives, mining relics and stunning scenery, will have us reaching for our cameras at every turn. As we depart Queenstown, we stop to the view the beautiful Horsetail Falls.

This afternoon, we capture another set of Tasmania's renowned waterfalls, Nelson Falls. A beautiful rainforest walk is rewarded by one of Tasmania's prettiest falls.

We continue on, climbing up to the plateau and towards Australia's deepest freshwater lake, Lake St. Claire. We make a stop here to take in the breathtaking views from the jetty that overlooks this beautiful tranquil lake

This evening we enjoy dinner at our hotel.



DAY 9. Sat 14 November 2020 B D HOBART

After breakfast, we return to Hobart via the Picturesque Lyell Highway (Western Wilds route) to explore the historic townships of Hamilton and New Norfolk. The small rural town of Hamilton still has the feel of a 1800's village with many of the town's small shops dating back to convict times.

This afternoon, we visit the states oldest National Park, Mount Field National Park. Russell Falls is the star attraction and even featured on Australia's first stamp. This diverse National Park is also home to Lady Barron Falls and Horseshoe Falls and offers an array of natural wonders and an incredible plant diversity that increases with altitude. As we head closer to Hobart, we enter New Norfolk, a bustling town on the River Derwent with a rich history, quality produce and pretty rural scenery.

Tonight our farewell dinner will be overlooking Hobart Waterfront at a local restaurant.

DAY 10. Sun 15 November 2020 B HOBART - MACKAY


Just because its our last day, don't think you can put your camera away! We rise nice and early, and head down to our last photo spot of the trip, sunrise over the Tessellated Pavement. A geological masterpiece awaits us along the coastline of the Tasman Peninsula. As the sun rises, the rock formations and rock pools come to life with colours and reflection. A perfect way to start our last day.

If time permits, we can head a little further down the peninsula and check out the rock formations of the Devil's Kitchen and Waterfall Bay.


From the Tasman Peninsula, we head back to Hobart for breakfast at the hotel, before we are transferred to the airport for our flight home to Mackay.

Suggestions - what to bring

There is no 'one' right camera or lens to bring on a trip like this, there are infinite combinations of gear that could be used depending on your style and what type of photos you like to take. At the end of the day, whether you have a full frame DSLR, or an iPhone you can work with what you have and get amazing photos. However, to give yourself creative options for capturing the epic Tasmanian landscapes, ideally you have the following:

- Any camera with the ability to manually control settings (especially to allow longer exposures, even the newer smartphones have options to do this)
- A tripod
- Wide angle lens
- A neutral density filter (this will help with those longer exposures and creating those beautiful silky waterfall shots)
